Section 8

Saugeen Rail Trail to Saugeen Concession 6

OBJECTIVE:

To develop and open the section of Non-Motorized trail (Part of Section 8) which runs from the South boundary of the Saugeen Rail Trail (west side of Mill Creek bridge) in the Municipality of Saugeen Shores to Concession 6. This would also be part of the Central Loop outlined in the Town of Saugeen Shores Parks & Trails Master Plan. The following Categories and Activities will need to be completed prior to trail opening.

Saugeen Concession 6 to Saugeen Concession 4

OBJECTIVE:

To develop and open the section of Parallel trail (Part of Section 8) which runs from Concession 6 in the Municipality of Saugeen Shores to Concession 4. The Non-Motorized Trail to follow the Rail Bed as outlined in the BCRTMC Master Plan and will be developed and maintained By the Saugeen Rail Trail and the CN North Trail Group. The Motorized trail to run parallel East of the Rail Bed near the East Fence line to be developed and maintained by the CN North Trail Group. This would also be part of the Central Loop outlined in the Town of Saugeen shores Parks & Trails Master Plan. The following Categories and Activities will need to be completed prior to trail opening.

Saugeen Concession 4 to Saugeen Concession 2

OBJECTIVE:

To develop and open the section of Parallel trail (Part of Section 8) which runs from Concession 4 in the Municipality of Saugeen Shores to Concession 2. The Non-Motorized Trail to follow the Rail Bed as outlined in the BCRTMC Master Plan and will be developed and maintained By the Saugeen Rail Trail Group and the CN North Trail Group. The Motorized trail to run parallel East of the Rail Bed near the East Fence line to the point where Keith Snyder Construction driveway starts. At this point the motorized trail will run along the Rail bed. The motorized trail is to be developed and maintained by the CN North Trail Group. This would also be part of the Central Loop outlined in the Town of Saugeen shores Parks & Trails Master Plan. The following Categories and Activities will need to be completed prior to trail opening.

Note- The motorized trail will be developed south from Keith Snyder driveway near the east fence over the next five years.

Saugeen Concession 2 to Saugeen Shores Boundary

OBJECTIVE:

To develop and open the section of Parallel trail (Part of Section 8) which runs from Concession 2 in the Municipality of Saugeen Shores to the Saugeen shores boundary. The Non-Motorized Trail to follow the Rail Bed as outlined in the BCRTMC Master Plan and will be developed and maintained By the Saugeen Rail Trail Group and the CN North Group. The Motorized trail to follow the Rail bed as a single trail and be developed and maintained by the CN North Trail Group. This would also be part of the Central Loop outlined in the Town of Saugeen shores Parks & Trails Master Plan. The following Categories and Activities will need to be completed prior to trail opening. Note- The motorized trail will be moved to near the east fence over a five year period.
